



How to donate to us.

Mindful and thoughtful donating is an important part of our work. The following guidelines ensure that recipients stay safe and valued.

Donations that are not up-to-scratch cost us in dumping fees and time. Please help us make the process seamless for everyone.

Child carseats:

Donated car seats and capsules must be freshly cleaned (the fabric cover and the main base), and be from a smoke-free home. They must be at least 6 months within the expiry date, and have an upper tether strap that clips onto an anchor point.

Bedding:

We often accept brand new, and quality second-hand bedding from smoke-free homes. All second-hand bedding must be freshly washed, and free of stains and holes. Unless we've recently released a call-out for bedding, please check with us first via [Facebook](#) before donating.

Furniture and white ware:

We ask for furniture as it's needed by the organisations we work with. It must be from smoke-free homes, and be very tidy and free of stains and holes. This is important. Please check with us first via [Facebook](#) before donating furniture. We may ask for dimensions and a photos.

Clothing:

We occasionally accept clothing donations following specific requests from refuges. Please check with us via [Facebook](#) before donating. Clothing must be freshly washed, from smoke-free homes, and be free of stains and holes. You get extra brownie points if you put it in a bag labelled with the size. New clothing with tags is always welcome.

Toys and books:

Unless we release a specific request, we do not accept second-hand toys and books. This is because we only provide toys for birthday and Christmas, so it is essential they are new with packaging intact.
